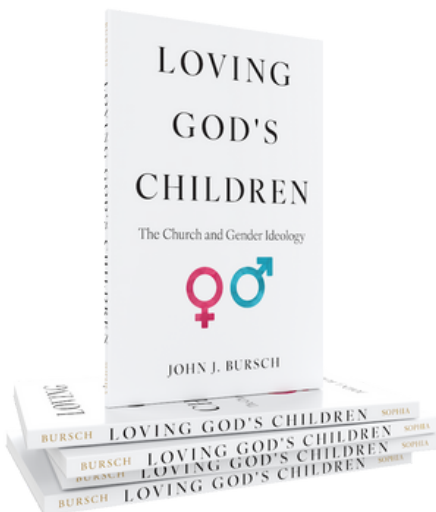

Lenten Book: Loving God's Children

THIS TIMELY BOOK HELPS EXPLAIN WHAT THE CATHOLIC CHURCH TEACHES ABOUT THE HUMAN PERSON AND WHY MODERN CULTURE'S EMBRACE OF "GENDER IDEOLOGY" IS NOT ONLY WRONG BUT TERRIBLY DANGEROUS FOR PARENTS AND FAMILIES, FEMALE ATHLETES, MEDICAL PROFESSIONALS — AND ESPECIALLY THOSE EXPERIENCING GENDER CONFUSION. DRAWING FROM CHURCH DOCUMENTS AND EXTENSIVE SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH, BURSCH ANSWERS NUMEROUS QUESTIONS THAT CONFRONT CATHOLICS LIVING IN A CULTURE THAT PROMOTES GENDER FLUIDITY. 40 HOURS ADORATION DEVOTION



WHAT IS 40 HOURS?

This is over a 500-year-old tradition of spending 40 continuous hours in adoration of the Blessed sacrament. St Philip Neri started the devotion in the city of Rome. This devotion commemorates the 40 hours that our Lord Jesus spent in the tomb. It's traditionally done either in the fall or the spring of the year. The springtime of the year right before Lent is to do Penance for the sins of carnival. It is an excellent opportunity for us during this year of the Eucharist to put our minds and our hearts in the right place for the beginning of the season of Lent. **The Lord must not be left alone for one second during these 40 hours.**
