Immediate Openings:

We still have eight days without bussing. Dismissal gets a little better each day. A couple things to remember:

- 1. Watch your speed
- 2. Begin a second lane on the back side of school to keep traffic off Northland Dr
- 3. Please STAY IN LINE! When cars make a u-turn in the middle of the line it is UNSAFE! We will release you as soon as we safely are able
- 4. We try to fill 4 or 5 cars with kids and then release each line at one time. This allows us to get the kids in place to get in the cars quickly and keep them SAFE. Please be patient if you have to wait. We can't afford to have any of our teachers get run over.
- 5. Pull all the way up to the front for loading. Watch for directions. Please stay in your vehicles and help buckle younger kids once you have left the line and are in the parking lot.
- 6. FAMILY NAME SIGNS HELP! Post your signs on your visor or hold them up. We can't read the name if it is lying on your dashboard.
- 7. If a teacher is frantically waving to get you to pull forward, please do so. We will bring your children to you!
