

OLC Dress Code

Middle School 6-8 2020 - 2021

Slacks

Khaki or navy blue dress or corduroy pants without studs, rivets or tags. No Cargo or Jogger pants.

Shorts

Khaki or navy blue dress walking shorts/capris without studs, rivets or tags, must be knee length. No Cargo shorts. Shorts may not be worn to Mass

Shirts

Plain red, navy blue, light blue or white collared dress, polo or turtleneck, Shirt must be visible beneath sweater, vest or sweatshirt
OLC logo is only acceptable logo
Shirts must be tucked in inside the building

Sweaters, Vests & Sweatshirts

Navy blue, gray or red sweaters or vests
*Blue, red or gray OLC sweatshirts, OLC fleece vests or OLC ¼ zip shirts.
Tie-dyed sweatshirts or sports jerseys may only be worn on game day or Friday for weekend games

Accessories

Neutral tone belt (required for 3rd-8th)
No make-up
No hats or headwear
No dangling earrings. No earrings for boys.
No distracting accessories
Hair must be of a naturally occurring color.
Dyed hair of any unnatural color is not permitted. Any eccentric hairstyles or designs are not permitted.

Footwear

Matching socks must be worn at all times, only solid white, black or navy blue are allowed for boys, only white, navy blue or red are allowed for girls.

Dress shoes or athletic shoes in good condition
No sandals, clogs, heels higher than 2 inches, boots (including fashion boots) or open-backed shoes allowed in the classroom

Clean gym shoes required for gym class

Color Days

Please see monthly calendar for dates
All clothes must be knee length and modest in fit and coverage
No tank tops or sleeveless shirts
Jeans without holes or rips may be worn
No leggings, yoga or work-out pants are allowed.
All graphics, logos or sayings should be school appropriate

Additionally for Girls

Skirts and Skorts

Khaki or navy blue
Must be knee length

Leggings

Only white or navy blue leggings may be worn **under** jumpers, skirts or skorts only.

Any item, whether listed or not, that is deemed inappropriate by staff will not be permitted.

Consequences for Dress Code Violations

1. Verbal warning

3. Detention (before/after school or during lunch recess)
