Dear School Families,

Back on August 6, 2020, you received a letter from Fr. Tony Russo, the OLC School Board, OLCEF trustees and myself, outlining the financial situation of the education foundation and the struggle to meet our growing needs. We asked all families to prayerfully consider their pledge of time, talent, and treasure.

On behalf of all of us, please accept our gratitude for completing your parent covenant and OLCEF pledge. As of today, we have collected 91% of the covenants. The School Board of Directors laid out the following goals, timelines, and checkpoints. Our goals for the last month were to

- Record 100% of school family pledges Status: 91.3%
- Decrease the percentage of givers in the 0 to <\$1,000 category to 15% Status:15.3%
- Record and track alternate givers for registered families. Status:
- Increase the the % of fulfilled pledges to 90% Status: In Progress

The board and finance council met several times over the last four weeks. Looking at the total pledged and the total needed to cover expenses, we have come to the difficult decision that a different funding model is crucial for the school to continue its mission of providing quality Catholic education in the Rockford and surrounding area.

Beginning the 2021-2022 school year, we will change our funding model to a tuition based model. This affords us the opportunity to

- Increase our spending for each individual student
- Expand staff infrastructure
- Retain and attract high quality teachers
- Update learning materials
- Enhance student services
